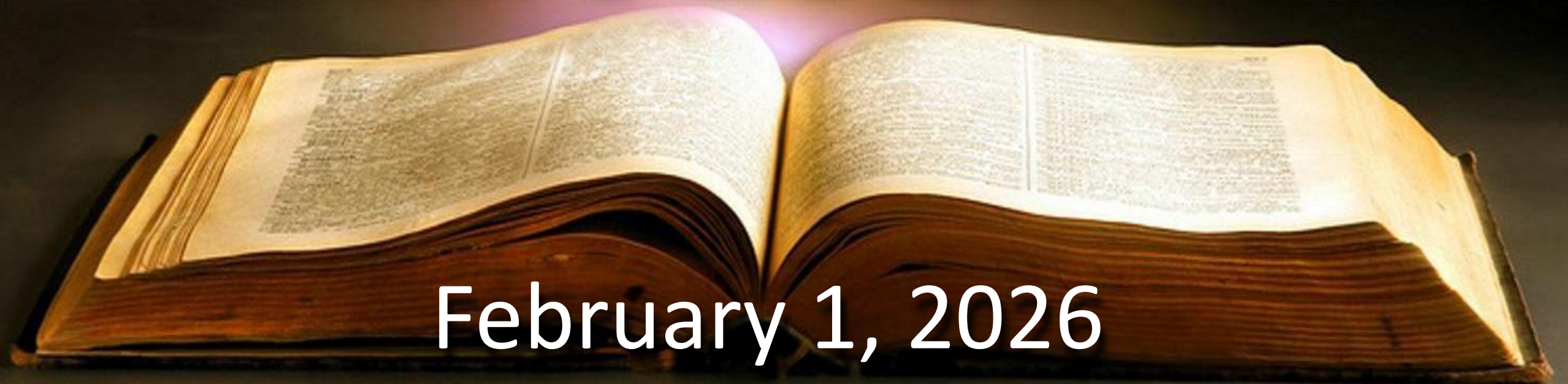

## The Model

Luke 6:35-45 (NKJV)

<sup>35</sup> But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil. <sup>36</sup> Therefore be merciful, just as your Father also is merciful. <sup>37</sup> "Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.

**Do not consider another insignificant or unworthy of mercy –  
Do not seek the destruction of another – seek reconciliation –  
The same method you use will come back to you!**

Luke 6:35-45 (NKJV)

Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck that is in your brother's eye.

<sup>43</sup> "For a good tree does not bear bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit. <sup>44</sup> For every tree is known by its own fruit. For *men* do not gather figs from thorns, nor do they gather grapes from a bramble bush.

**Matthew 12:35**

"A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things."

"A hypercritical, hypocritical disease of the soul that constantly finds fault with what others say and do. It is the attitude of the critic who "arrogantly assumes a superiority that entitles him or her to assess the failings of others," [Douglas R.A. Hare, Bible Commentary page 76]

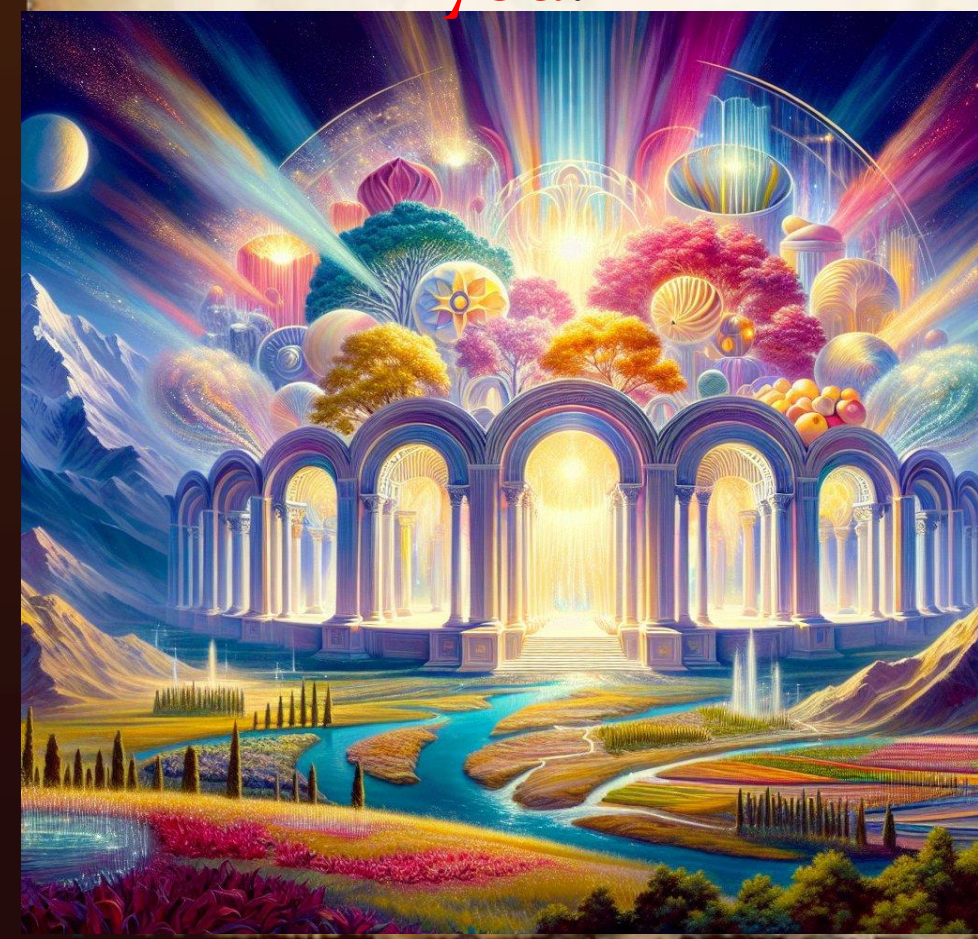
Nature of the Judgement "Forbidden"

2:1-3;

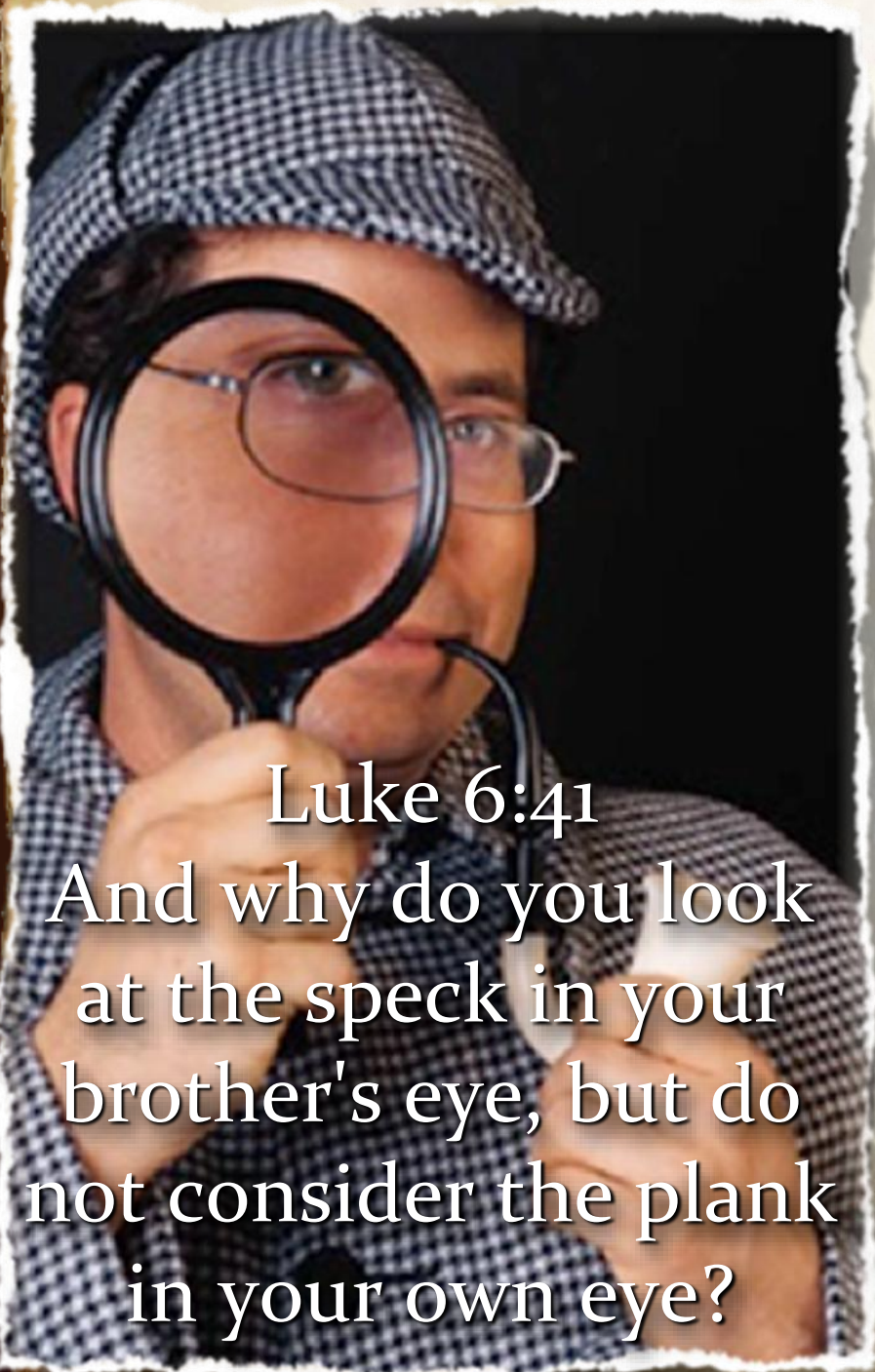
❖ **Because of our self righteousness**

# Judgment Without Mercy

Nature of the Judgement “Forbidden”

## What Is This Text Teaching Us?



Luke 6:42

...Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck that is in your brother's eye.

- ❖ We must engage in honest & Serious introspection –  
2 Cor. 13:5
- ❖ Correcting our own sinful actions and attitudes so we can Effectively help others –  
Gal. 6:1-3
- ❖ We need Sufficient humility to deal patiently with others –  
Titus 3:2,3
